- 1. It is the policy of the Haywood County Beekeeper's Chapter (HCBC) to protect the confidentiality of our guests, and to tell you that any information we may collect is solely for internal use.
- 2. The host server automatically recognizes no information about the domain, or email address of the visitor to our web site.
