



Suggested Varroa Mite Treatment Protocol Three Treatments Per Year

1. December

- Oxalic Acid Vapor – 4 gram dose (Api-Bioxal or EZ-Ox)
- Oxalic Acid Sugar Syrup Dribble

2. Spring / Early Summer

- Amitraz (Apivar strips or Amiflex gel)
- Thymol (Apiguard 60-100°F or ApiLife VAR 64-95°F)

Only Options Approved for use during Honey Flow!

- Formic Acid (Formic PRO) 1 pad at a time – 82°F or below
- Oxalic Acid-Extended Release Strips (VarroxSan) – Coming late summer 2024

3. August / September

- Amitraz (Apivar strips or Amiflex gel)
- Thymol (Apiguard 60-100°F or ApiLife VAR 64-95°F)
- Formic Acid (Formic PRO) 1 pad at a time – 82°F or below
- ??? Oxalic Acid-Extended Release Strips (VarroxSan) – POSSIBLY EFFECTIVE
